So I got to the bottom and pushed up and it looked dark and I could see it getting lighter and lighter but before I got to the surface, I really needed air and my lungs were burning and aching. And I needed that air. I desperately needed that air. And when I broke the surface, I was sputtering and gasping, needing that air. And I think the Lord reminded me of that because we said that He was going to be the air we breathe. And He wants to know if we need Him that much. Do we need Him that much as the air we breathe and the water we drink?
