

INSPIRED WORD

June 5, 2019

PRAYER

Dear Lord, thank You so much for this night. Thank You for the breath that You gave us, the life that You put in our bodies, and God, tonight we dedicate our whole selves to You and we give our breath in worship and praise of You tonight, Lord. God, we are just so happy to be in Your presence, and we want to tell You we love You tonight, and we come expectantly to see what You would like to tell us, God. We listen to You and we praise You and worship You tonight, and we thank You, in Jesus' name. Amen.

SCRIPTURE

Revelation 19:11-16: *Then I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse! He who sat upon it is called faithful and true. With justice he judges and makes war. His eyes are blazing like fire, and on his head are many crowns. He has a name written on him that no one knows but him. He is dressed in robes dipped in blood and on his name is the Word of God. The armies of the heavens were following him, riding on white horses and dressed in fine linens, white and clean. Out of his mouth came a sharp sword, with which to strike down the nations. He will rise then with an iron scepter; he treads the wine press with the fury of the wrath of God Almighty. On his robe and on his thigh he has a name written – King of kings and Lord of lords.*

IMAGE

I don't know if this has any reference but I was passing in the back of the church and I noticed the image of (...) stripping Jesus of His robes. I got a feel that the world does that to us and to Him. But even though He is stripped of His robes, He is still glorious. And that act of mercy triumphs over evil.

SCRIPTURE

Judith 9:11: *Your strength is not in numbers, nor does your power depend on strong men. For you are the God of the lowly, the helper of the oppressed, the supporter of the weak, the protector of the forsaken, the savior of those without hope.*

IMAGE

I've been seeing this image of a big throng of people gathered; angels coming in our midst bringing strength like the Lord was strengthened by an angel before His time on the cross. He's bringing that strength to us now. The joy of the Lord is our strength.

SCRIPTURE

From **Revelation 6:9-11:** *When he opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of those who had been slain for the word of God and for the testimony which they held. And they cried with a loud voice saying, "How long, Lord, holy and true, until you judge and avenge our blood on those who dwell on the earth?" Then a white robe was given to each of them and it*

was said of them that they should rest a while longer until both the number of their fellow servants and their brethren, who would be killed, was completed.

SCRIPTURE / SENSE / EXHORTATION

I found a verse that kind of really spoke to me tonight and then I lost it. And it's in Isaiah somewhere but there're 66 chapters so I'm not going to find it again in time. But the heart of it was... it was a two or three sentence paragraph and it was called "The Return from Captivity." And the Lord basically said "You can come home. You've had your time when you've been a captive in Babylon and you can now come home. And people are going to come with you to your home and there will be a turnabout because those who made you slaves will become your slaves" (**Isaiah 45:13-14**). And while we're not asking people to hold and make slaves at this point, I think what the Lord was trying to point out is that what He restores He doesn't just fix it, He exalts it. And it's okay to trust Him, that the Lord of lords and the King of kings, the one whose sword was in His mouth, will not just fix things in this world, in our lives. When He comes as Savior, He restores and He glorifies. And glorifies is a whole lot bigger and a whole lot better than just fixing. So when we look for social justice to be fixed in the world, let's look at the Savior and let's glorify; let's go beyond restoration. And when we look at our sins and we say, "I can't get past this, Lord", let Him be your Savior and take you past getting past it, to glorify it, to go to the next level of glory with Him because He's working in you in that Holy Spirit within your heart.

IMAGE / SCRIPTURE / PROPHECY

Thank You, Holy Spirit, for working in our hearts. As we began tonight, I saw an image of a door opening and light was shining through. But before the door opened, it was as if someone was looking through a window in the door, and they weren't sure. And they began to open the door and the light just was very bright and shining through. The Lord led me to the scripture in **Revelation 3:20-21** that says: *Listen. I am standing at the door knocking. If you hear my voice and open the door, I will come in to you and eat with you and you with me. To the one who conquers, I will give a place with me on my throne, just as I myself conquered and sat down with my Father on His throne.*" And then I heard the Word saying, "Hearts are opening. Unsure hearts are opening to me. Open wide the doors."

SHARING / PROPHECY

It all started when I painted this. This is an image of Our Lady of Mount Carmel rescuing the souls. When I painted this, that night Satan attacked me for doing it. After the prayer meeting last week, I started getting revelations both from Mary and from Jesus, something I've never had before like this. It literally felt like God was ripping these words out of me. "My dearest child, I ask you to speak these words I spoke to you in the tabernacle last week. June is the month dedicated to my Sacred Heart, which has loved mankind and has received little in return, even from my followers. I call each of you this night to worship me in my tabernacle. In my Sacred Heart I call you. Praise me, not just sing beautiful songs or play music but to do so to me. I also call you to be soldiers and warriors of prayer, every day, not just Sundays and Wednesdays but every day. This is how we will win the battle and the triumph of my heart and my Mother's Immaculate Heart will come out." Mary also reminded me of a city in Istanbul that used to be a heart of Christianity and is now a Muslim city under Muslim rule. And she warns that this is a danger that could happen here, because of complacency. "I also call you to make

reparations for those trusted to speak my word in your world who have unworthily spoken heresy and those who have violated their vows, bishops and priests, and who have scandalized my faith, causing them to turn away from my church. Pray for these people, especially those who have betrayed me like Judas. I love Judas but I love Peter and call them like Peter to repent. I remain (...) who in full speech of you in my Sacred Heart together with my Mother who holds you in the Immaculate Heart. Your loving Savior and Friend, prisoner in the tabernacle, Jesus Christ.”

WORD OF KNOWLEDGE

I believe there's someone here that just cannot open the door to the Lord totally. And the Lord is saying to you: “My beloved one, over and over I have told you of my love for you. I have told you that I knock on the door of your heart and yet you hesitate out of fear, out of fear of what I might call you to. And I say to you, my beloved one, once again I knock on the door of your heart and I say to you - open it fully, my beloved one, you have nothing to fear. For what I ask of you is not to harm you but to build you up and to use you to build up others. Let go completely, my beloved one. Let me in, for indeed my presence is here and the joy that you shall experience will overcome anything that you fear that you might dislike. So now I say to you, open your heart to me.”

EXHORTATION

As we prepare to sing this song, let's remember that the Word is not just the scriptures. The Word is Jesus. “I am the Word” spoken by the Lord. He wants us to be a lamp to our feet, a light unto our path, to be held close to our hearts, like Mel was talking about. Cling to the Word, Jesus, tonight, right now. Jesus, I trust in You.

SCRIPTURE / IMAGE

This is from **Haggai 2:6-9**: *This is what the Lord Almighty says: In a little while I will once more shake the heavens and the earth, the sea and the dry land. I will shake all nations and what is desired by all nations will come. And I will fill this house with glory, says the Lord Almighty. The silver is mine and the gold is mine, declares the Lord Almighty. The glory of this present house will be greater than the glory of the former house, says the Lord Almighty. And in this place I will grant peace, declares the Lord Almighty.* And the image that I kind of had with that as we were singing the song “Breathe” and thinking about how we can't compare what may have been before, the house plans that may have been before, to what is coming now. And in the image I saw the cross on the ground with ropes being raised, almost like a house-raising, but it was the cross of Christ. And that's what we have to look to is His cross; it's Him leading the way; it's as He is being raised up, in His suffering and in His death and in His resurrection, that we look to that.

PRAYER

You know Pentecost is this Sunday. Let's say a prayer that the Holy Spirit come in power. Come, Holy Spirit, come, Lord. Touch the hearts of Your people. Kindle in them the fire of Your love. Lord, come, send forth Your Spirit. We want a new Pentecost, Lord, a mighty fire in the hearts of Your people, a mighty fire in the hearts of Your church. Come, O Lord, in Your power. Lord, we need You more than ever, Spirit of the Living God and we pray for that fresh

anointing upon Your church, upon Your people, upon us. And we ask this in the name of Jesus, the Lord. Amen.
