PRAYER

Lord, we just come before You tonight. We just thank You so much for this beautiful bluebird sky day. Your creation is so majestic. We are so grateful for this place where we live. Open our hearts tonight to hear Your word. Open our minds to experience Your love. Open our hearts to know You in a deeper way. We ask this in Jesus' blessed name. Amen.

PRAYER

In trials, O Jesus, Your grace is enough. O Lord, in the darkness, Your grace is enough. O Lord, on the mountain top, Your grace is enough. O Lord, in all circumstances, Your grace is enough. O Lord, You poured forth an abundance. We don't even have to ask for it but we do ask for it. Pour all Your graces, Your strength, O God, into our weakness. Glory to You! Your energy, O God. Your grace is enough, O Jesus. Thank You! Thank You! We just thank You for the praise reports this evening. It's so wonderful to hear Your saving action. It's so wonderful to hear of Your presence in all the circumstances of life. Not only present but caring, and not only present but healing. O Jesus, we thank You. We thank You for Your holy presence here tonight, Lord. You walk among us.

PRAYER / EXHORTATION

Our help does come from the Lord. Lord, we lift our eyes up to You in this place, in this temple tonight. And we know You hear and look at every heart and every circumstance, O Lord. Your eyes are upon us and so is Your love, O Jesus. It's hard to keep silent when you know the Lord is pouring forth His love upon us. It's hard to keep silent when we know where our help comes from. And it's hard to keep silent when we know it always comes from Him. Thank you, Jesus Christ, glory to You.

EXHORTATION / SCRIPTURE

The part of the song that we were really able to pray strongly, that we knew well, was the part "I lift my eyes to the one who helps me, who my help comes from." And that's the part to remember to take home with us in our hearts. That's what praise reports are all about, that we lift our eyes to the Lord and He is our Savior, and He is our comfort and He walks with us through the valley of the dark shadow and we fear no evil because He is by our side, His rod and His staff beside Him (**referencing Psalms 23:4**).

PRAYER

Lord, You are the rock upon which we stand, secure in the midst of the wind and in the midst of the waves, in the midst of the tides, in the midst of the earthquakes. O Lord, you are the solid rock upon which we stand. You are the firm foundation, O Jesus, and we need not fear. No matter what is happening, no matter what we see, we stand on You, Lord, the solid rock, the firm foundation. Jesus, we stand on You. O let the waves crash, O let the tides come. And even so, and even so, and even so, we stand firm, confident that we stand on You, the rock, Jesus. Praise You! Praise Your faithfulness! Praise You, Lord! And let me speak this, Lord. We speak truth, we speak truth. You are our firm foundation. Mighty are You. In You we trust.

PRAYER / EXHORTATION

We recognize who You are and all Your many aspects. We turn our eyes to You. We offer our hearts to You. We proclaim You are the Lord.

SHARING / IMAGE / PRAYER

I know I haven't been here in quite awhile but as we were praising and worshiping God, it just seemed to me that the Holy Spirit was hovering over this people. He was hovering and just over the Holy Spirit I could see the host of angels. I don't exactly know how to say it. Over and above the Holy Spirit and it was just a beautiful thing. Father, we just thank You for Your presence. O Holy Spirit, thank You for Your presence and we just thank You that You continue to allow us to continue to come into Your presence. We praise You and exalt You and magnify Your holy name. For You, O Lord, are worthy of all praise. You are worthy of all praise, and honor, and glory, and we just want to continue praising You as long as You allow us. And we just want to praise You and exalt You and magnify Your holy name. For You are worthy of all praise, worthy of all honor, and worthy of all glory. For You are the King of Kings; You are the Lord, Most High. Alleluia to the King of Kings! Glory to Your most holy name! Alleluia to the King!

PRAYER

Lord, we'd just like to dwell in this temple that You have created, a living sanctuary to Your Holy Spirit. For us to hear with Your voice, to see with Your eyes, and rest in Your peace. Lord, we ask You to still the way, to quiet the storm, still our fear and help us trust You.

WORD OF KNOWLEDGE

I'm sensing that someone needs prayer, needs prayer for something that is happening internally and needs healing prayer. If that's you, raise your hand so we can see where you are. (pause) Okay, well, all I know is that I was to say that so I'll stand on it. And if you recognize yourself later as being that person, let me know or make sure we're aware of that and we will pray for you.

MESSAGE IN TONGUES

PRAYER / INTERPRETATION

I want to be holy. I want to be a sanctuary. But to be My sanctuary, just as it (.....) is gold inside of you. Holy, Holy, Holy, Sanctus, Sanctus, Sanctus. You must first be holy, holy, holy. Then you can be My sanctuary.

INTERPRETATION / IMAGE

I heard Him shouting, dancing, praising, "I'm alive! Alive!"

SHARING

I felt the Spirit touch me a little and He was saying to me, "Go up and say hi." And He said, "Before you can be a sanctuary, you have to be holy." I am called and here to proclaim my faith, my glorious Catholic faith, to each and every one of you: I confess to almighty God and to you, my brothers and sisters, that I have greatly sinned, in my thoughts and in my words, in what I have done and in what I have failed to do, through my fault, through my fault, though my most grievous fault. Therefore I ask, Blessed Mary, ever Virgin, all the angels and saints, and you, my brothers and sisters, to pray for me to the Lord our God (**penitential prayer**).

PRAYER

Lord, we all say that and Your mercy pours forth upon us and Your love.

PROPHECY / WORD OF KNOWLEDGE

Now, my brother, I speak these words to you. I see in your heart and I see that you are My beautiful creation. There has been sin but I have forgiven you. I have forgiven because I love you and I take you here in this night. See My love. Remove your eyes from the sin and see My love. Often I see to you, often I call you. I tell you that you are gifted, that you are graced, that you are My beloved, and that is what I seek for you to understand and to hold in your heart – My love, My tremendous, My unconditional, My gift-giving love for you. For I see you as the beauty of My creation. I see you as the beauty of My love. And I desire for you to see yourself in the same way. You are forgiven; you are loved.

CONFIRMATION

I would like to confirm that with a scripture from **Romans 4:7**: *Blessed are they whose iniquities are forgiven and whose sins are covered. Blessed is the man whose sin the Lord does not record.*

PROPHECY

And I've been hearing: Your earthly temple shall fall but the Lord God will be with you forever.

SCRIPTURE / PRAYER

Before we came out to this prayer meeting I got the scripture from **Isaiah 6:1-8** (it's the quote of Isaiah the prophet). He says: *The Lord was sitting on his throne, high and exalted, and his robe filled the whole temple and around him creatures were standing and each had six wings and each creature covered its face with two and its body with two wings and two for flying. They were calling out to each other: Holy, holy, holy. The Lord Almighty is holy. His glory fills the temple, fills the world.*” And the sound of their voices made the foundation of the temple shake and the temple itself became filled with smoke. I said, “There’s no hope for me. I am doomed because every word that passes my lips is sinful and I am among a people whose every word is sinful and yet with my own eyes I have seen the King, the Lord of heaven.” And one of the creatures flew down to me carrying a burning coal that he had taken from the altar with a pair of tongs. He touched my lips with the burning coal and said, “This unsticks your lips and now your guilt is gone and your sins are forgiven.” I heard the Lord say, “Who shall I send? Who will be our messenger?” And I answered, “I will go. Send me.” Holy, holy, holy, Lord, pouring forth your mercy upon us. We are the recipients of your love, of your grace and of your forgiveness.
