

INSPIRED WORD
October 7, 2015

SCRIPTURE

Psalm 9: 1-2: I will praise You, O Lord, with all my heart; I will tell of all Your wonders. I will be glad and rejoice in You; I will sing praise to Your Name, O Most High.

SCRIPTURE

Psalm 29: 1 – 2: Give to the Lord, you sons of God, give to the Lord glory and praise, give to the Lord the glory due His Name; adore the Lord in holy attire.

SCRIPTURE

Psalm 30: 12 – 13: You changed my mourning into dancing; You took off my sackcloth and clothed me with gladness, that my soul might sing praise to You without ceasing; O Lord, my God, forever will I give You thanks.

SCRIPTURE

Psalm 33: 1 – 3: Rejoice, you just, in the Lord; praise from the upright is fitting. Give thanks to the Lord on the harp; on the ten-stringed lyre offer praise. Sing to God a new song; skillfully play with joyful chant.

SCRIPTURE

Psalm 66: 1 – 2: Shout joyfully to God, all you on earth; sing of His glorious Name; give Him glorious praise.

SCRIPTURE

Psalm 81: 1 – 2: Sing joyfully to God our strength; shout in triumph to the God of Jacob! Take up a melody, sound the timbrel, the sweet-sounding harp and lyre.

SCRIPTURE

Psalm 149: 1 – 6: Hallelujah! Sing to the Lord a new song, a hymn in the assembly of the faithful. Let Israel be glad in their Maker, the people of Zion rejoice in their King. Let them praise His Name in festive dance; make music with tambourine and lyre. For the Lord takes delight in His people, honors the poor with victory. Let the faithful rejoice in their glory, cry out for joy at their banquet, with the praise of God in their mouths
, and a two-edged sword in their hands.

SCRIPTURE / PRAYER

Isaiah 58: 10 – 12: If you bestow your bread on the hungry and satisfy the afflicted; then light shall rise for you in the darkness, and the gloom shall become for you like midday; then the Lord will guide you always and give you plenty even on the parched land. He will renew your strength, and you shall be like a watered garden, like a spring whose water never fails. The ancient ruins shall be rebuilt for your sake, and the foundations from ages past you shall raise up; “Repairer of the breach,” they shall call you, “Restorer of ruined homesteads.” Father, thank You for calling us to be the repairer of the breach and the restorer of streets with dwellings. I ask that You continue to make that clear to us – that path which we are supposed to walk. We praise and exalt You and magnify Your Holy Name! You are the King of kings! You are the Righteous Lamb of God and You are righteous in all Your ways!!

SCRIPTURE

Philippians 2: 10 – 11: And so, in honor of the Name of Jesus all beings in heaven, on earth, and in the world below will fall on their knees, and all will openly proclaim that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

SCRIPTURE

John 14: 6 – 7: Jesus answered, “I am the Way, the Truth and the Life. No one comes to the Father except through Me. If you know Me, then you will also know My Father. From now on you do know Him and have seen Him.”

SCRIPTURE

Psalms 138: I thank You, Lord, with all my heart; before the gods to You I sing. I bow low toward Your holy Temple; I praise Your name for Your fidelity and love. For You have exalted over all Your name and Your promise. When I cried out, You answered; You strengthened my spirit. All the kings of earth will praise You, Lord, when they hear the words of Your mouth. They will sing of the ways of the Lord: “How great is the glory of the Lord!” The Lord is on high, but cares for the lowly and knows the proud from afar. Though I walk in the midst of dangers, You guard my life when my enemies rage. You stretch out Your hand; Your right hand saves me. The Lord is with me to the end. Lord, Your love endures forever. Never forsake the work of Your hands!

PRAYER

Lord, help us to trust in You in all circumstances! Jesus, Jesus, You are Lord, be the Lord of our hearts, our circumstances, our troubles, our joys, and our families! Glory to You, O God!

PRAYER

Lord God, I know how much I need You! I know how much I cling to those things that keep me from You, and, Lord, I want to renounce all of them, I want them to be gone! I want to live in victory, I want to exist in love, not fear. Lord, I want to know You and experience You in a new way. Lord, bring me to Your altar! I lay my burdens down and as my heart is broken, give me a new heart of flesh, O God. For You are holy, You are righteous, and You are victorious! In Jesus' name, we pray. Amen!

EXHORTATION / PROPHECY

We don't need to manufacture Christ, because we already know Who He is. We will praise Him! If we know the power of His sufferings, His death and resurrection, we will rejoice. We will experience the reality of God Who stretched out His hands between heaven and earth and said, “I love you this much! This much!! Don't keep the burdens for yourself because I have already paid them! I have already laid them down at the feet of the Father, and now they are His.” God says to us, “Rejoice in My Presence! Take joy in My Presence, and know that I am **with** you and know that I am **in** you, when you receive Me in the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and especially in the Sacrament of the altar. I have the power to transform you because I change the ‘very you’ of who you are.” The Eucharist literally becomes part of us; it doesn't stop us, but it transforms us. Let's rejoice in that transformation!

CONFIRMATION / SCRIPTURE

I want to confirm that! I was sitting over there with this Scripture in **John 6: 57:** Whoever eats My Flesh and drinks My Blood remains in Me, and I in him. Also in **Psalms 84: 4:** Happy are those who live in Your house; they are ever praising You.

PRAYER

Lord, I want to be used by You tonight by being open to the promptings of Your Spirit. Lord, touch my heart, and if You want me to speak, if You want me to share, if You have a word of Prophecy that You want to deliver through me, or give a message in Tongues, Wisdom or Knowledge, I am ready to receive them. Here I am, Lord! Use me that You may be glorified and Your love might touch others here in this assembly. Come, Holy Spirit! Come, Holy Spirit, and dwell in our hearts in this place tonight!

SCRIPTURE

Isaiah 42: 1 – 8: Here is My servant whom I uphold, My chosen one with whom I am pleased. Upon whom I have put My spirit; he shall bring justice to the nations. Not crying out, not shouting, not making His voice heard in the street. A bruised reed he shall not break, and a smoldering wick he shall not quench. Until he establishes justice on the earth; the coastlands will wait for His teaching. Thus says God, the Lord, Who created the heavens and stretched out the earth with its crops, Who gives breath to its people and spirit to those who walk on it; I, the Lord, have called you for the victory of justice, I have grasped you by the hand; I formed you, and set you as a covenant of the people, a light for the nations, to open the eyes of the blind, to bring prisoners from confinement, and from the dungeon, those who live in darkness. I am the Lord, this is My Name; My glory I give to no other.

IMAGE

I had the image of a pinwheel and each of us is a pinwheel. The winds of the Lord, the Spirit of the Lord keeps us twirling around. I can picture all those pinwheels and how pretty and fun that would be.

TONGUES

INTERPRETATION

I am here with My arms open wide, waiting for you to receive My sweet embrace.

INTERPRETATION

I have heard your words and have received your worship, as you have gathered around the throne. I want you to feel comfortable in My Presence. Do not be worried, do not be concerned; know that I love you! I am your God and I have received your words and your worship tonight.

INTERPRETATION

If you want Me to hold you, just come to Me with your arms outstretched.

PRAYER / EXHORTATION

Lord, we know that You welcome us and that You love us. We know that You want to embrace us. You call us to come to You with outstretched arms. That is a call to us – if you want to come closer to the Lord, stretch out your arms now and say, “Yes, Lord, I want to receive Your embrace; I want to come closer to You in my life and in my walk. This night, this place here now, Lord, You beckon to us with love; Your arms are wide open, and You call us to come to You and receive Your embrace. Here we are, O Lord! Jesus, loving, merciful and forgiving Jesus!. Jesus, Jesus, speak in strength and encouragement in our hearts. Jesus, loving us; Jesus, calling us!

WORD OF KNOWLEDGE / PRAYER

Someone here has a pain in their right shoulder which goes down into their right arm. Someone else here is feeling like a knot back here and goes down through the neck and it is hurting really bad. Is that anyone here? In the Word of Knowledge, Lord, these people here are now standing. Lord, we ask You to bring healing to those specific areas and, Lord, Your word has said that You are willing to do the healing, so we just claim that as we pray for Your healing love to flow down all over these people standing here.

WORD OF KNOWLEDGE / PROPHECY

There is someone here who has an unforgiveness issue. It is affecting your stomach and you have been carrying this around for awhile. Here now in this place, the Lord says to you, "You may not think that you can do this, **but I can do this in you!** Say to me, 'Lord, help me', and then with My strength, say to that person who is not forgiven, '**I forgive you in Jesus' Name; I forgive you in Jesus' power; I forgive you in Jesus' love!**'" If you can say that here now in this place, the Lord honors that prayer, and that tightness and the hurt which you carry within you will be dissipated by the love of Christ. I am not going to ask you to stand, for you know if it is you who needs to forgive.

IMAGE

I had image of Jesus standing by each one of us. It is as if we are going out into a field and picking wild flowers. I think the wild flowers are things that we do during the day, like saying a kind word to someone, or reaching out and offering others support, or these kinds of things. These all make up the bouquet of wild flowers that we are giving to Jesus for the day.

SHARING

I keep hearing the word, 'Adonai' and I don't know what it means. (Adonai is a Hebrew name for God)

PROPHECY

The words that I heard earlier are these: "If you only knew the grace and the love that I have for you!"

EXHORTATION

The Lord says that He has filled us up so much with His love, and He asks us to go out and find those people who need Him. We are to feed them with this love of the Lord which is overflowing in us.

PRAYER

Lord, we thank You for Your holy Presence here tonight. We thank You for the words that You have given us in Scripture, in Prophecy, in Word of Knowledge, and we thank You for the Images which were given. We thank You, Lord, for calling us to Yourself with Your arms outstretched. You beckon us to come closer to You. Lord, You have a love that heals, a love that strengthens, a love that forgives. O Jesus, O Jesus, be Lord over us!
